

Every town or City needs at least one Irish Pub and Whistler has the Dubh Linn Gate. For anyone interested "Dubh Linn" is an Irish phrase which means "Black Pool" and is associated with the Capital of Ireland Dublin. Inside the Dubh Linn Gate no expense was spared importing an entire pub from Ireland piece by piece and reassembling in on the ground floor of the Pan Pacific Hotel. The Irish theme permeates through the beers on offer & the food plus they also have one of the widest selections of beer in Whistler. They also use 20oz imperial Pint glasses (*used in Ireland & UK*) which are larger than the standard 16oz pint common in most other pubs in Whistler



At night a mix of Irish acts and some local duos play in the main bar which are quite popular with tourists. The patio also attracts the Apres crowd as the Dubh Linn Gate is adjacent to the village Gondola and they usually provide live music to keep everyone entertained after a day on the hill. Although a beautiful Pub with great food it can be a little on the expensive side even just for drinks so beware if you are on a budget.
